

Forums

Along the toolbar on the top right-hand side of the page, you will find an area for Forums (note, Forums will only appear in the toolbar once you have signed in)



The idea behind forums is that it is an area of the system where volunteers can have discussions, share experiences or ask for advice from other volunteers, some of whom they might never have come in to contact with otherwise

You can choose to read or subscribe to existing forums, or to create new threads should you wish to engage with other forum members

To create a new thread, go to the top right-hand corner and click 'create new thread'

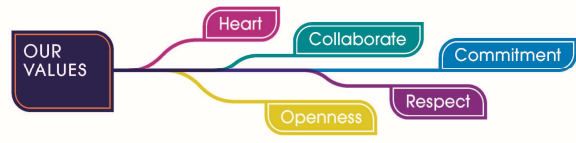
