


## Portal Home Page

Following sign in, you will be redirected to the home page. From here, you can navigate through the rest of the system and access useful functionality.




Along the task bar, there are four icons to choose from

Clicking on the Our Website icon will direct you straight through to the Association's website. Please note, clicking this will take you out of the portal and in to the website. If you would like to open it in a separate tab, right click and select either Open in new tab or Open in new window



The next icon, the home icon, will bring you back to the home page from anywhere else in the system

Clicking the Forums icon will take you through to the forums page, where they can choose to join or create conversations and discussion with other volunteers. This gives volunteers the option to discuss shared topics of interest or give advice

Clicking on the arrow will give all the options for navigating around the system. These options will differ depending on user role.
