Chenies Manor House is one of the UK's finest Tudor Mansion Houses. The Grade I Listed building is set in Buckinghamshire's charming estate village of Chenies and overlooks the Chess Valley. The venue's grounds boast award winning gardens and include a sunken garden, herbaceous borders, topiary, a fountain court and a physic garden. Chenies propagate 1500 plus dahlias each year and they are at their best in September.



Refreshments will be available and all proceeds will go to the Chiltern Branch of the MND Association to help local people living with the disease. MND is a fatal, rapidly progressing disease that affects the brain and spinal cord. It has no cure at present.

Entry to the Chenies Manor Gardens is £5pp on the day **with no charge for children or people living with MND, nor for one carer accompanying them.**
