

Giving in memory of someone special

Families may wish to ask for donations to the Association instead of flowers at a funeral, or instead of presents at a special anniversary, celebration or wedding. We can provide special gift envelopes to help with funeral and memorial collections or fundraising events.

It is designed to bring together in one place, the different in-memoriam fundraising activities which may be taking place in memory of a special person. Remember if the money is to be donated to your branch or group it is essential it says that on the relevant Just Giving page as it is important that it is clear to the public what they are donating to.

All donations, whether made through this service or by any other method, can be easily included in a Tribute Fund bearing the name of the special person.

A Tribute Fund is a constant, practical means of remembrance which also offers an optional memorial website providing extensive features to ensure a high degree of personalisation.
