#### What's involved?

- o Maintain up-to-date accounting records
- o Prepare accounts and financial statements for our national office and the Branch Management Committee on a quarterly basis
- o Budget for the use of the branch's financial resources in consultation with the Branch Management Committee and act as one of the bank signatories to the branch account
