



MND Support (Care) Grant

- Application must be completed by a health and social care professional (HSCP) after an assessment
- Submitted to support services team at national office
- Need to demonstrate that statutory funding has been sought and that application is because funding is not available or is not timely
- Up to £1,500 per application
- Can complete form online








Quality of Life grant


- Up to £500 per application
- For the person with MND
- Applications from person with MND, carer, relative, AV, ASC or HSCP
- Apply to local branch or support services team at national office
- Can complete form online





Carers Grant

- Up to £500 per year
- For main unpaid carer, aged 16 or over, of person with MND
- Applications from carer/family member, AV, ASC or HSCP
- Apply to local branch or support services team at national office
- Can complete form online
- Can be applied for up to 12 months post bereavement





Children and Young Person's grant

- Up to £250 per year
- For those 18 and under living with person with MND
- Application from any family member, AV, ASC or HSCP
- Apply to local branch or support services team at national office
- Can complete form online
- Can be applied for up to 12 months post bereavement








Cost of Living Support Fund

- One off
- Up to £350
- To help with household bills or food shopping costs
- Can complete form online
- Submitted to support services team at national office





We don't fund

- Equipment or adaptations which are a statutory responsibility
- Equipment for assessment by HSCPs
- Emergency healthcare needs
- Retrospective funding
- Funeral, legal or insurance costs

Exceptional Circumstances


There are times when we can consider grants outside the criteria as set out in the policy and guidance document




