A Branch or Group Campaigns Volunteer provides support to their respective Branch or Group by promoting campaigns across local communities and beyond with the MND Association.

Tasks and activities

- Proactively promote central campaigns online and via social media with direct support
- Engage with local councillors (eg. Via email or other local channels/ community forums) to improve services for people living with and affected by MND in your area
- Speak with MPs and decision-makers about what MND is and why it's important for people to have access to high quality health and care services
- Connect with regional MND Association staff and volunteers to identify issues and collaboratively gather evidence for local and national campaigns
- Link with working groups and other engagement channels to drive campaign agendas
- Adhere to the MND Association's policies and procedures, including Safeguarding
- Time commitment is flexible and variable depending on active campaigns and individual capacity.

This role is recruited through Safer Recruitment processes, which means it includes a structured interview and two references.

Successful applicants will complete a structured induction pathway, involving reviewing guidance and resources about MND Association campaigns and related activities.

There is ongoing support available via the MND Association Campaigns team.
