



## WHATIS MID?

Motor neurons are a type of nerve cell found in the brain and spinal cord. They pass messages from the brain to muscles to tell them to move.



In Motor neurone disease (MND), the motor neurons break down and cannot send signals from the brain to the muscles. This causes muscle wasting.
